

Sterile single use surgical instrument sets and single use surgical instruments for minor surgery, gynaecology, podiatry ophthalmology, ENT and wound care.

Annex V Sterility aspects only – Restricted to the aspects of manufacture concerned with securing and maintaining sterile conditions

Sterile instrument packs for procedures and supplementary packs, sterile single use surgical instrument sets and single use surgical instruments for minor surgery, gynaecology, podiatry ophthalmology, ENT and wound care - Manufactured in accordance with Article 12.

Annex V Metrological aspects only – Restricted to the aspects of manufacture concerned with the conformity of the devices with metrological requirements
